## Walking in a worthy manner

### Ephesians 4:1–6

1. Walk worthy of your calling...

2. ...because we really **are** one

### Discussion and reflection

This 'urging' comes from Paul, 'a prisoner for the Lord' (v1). How does that impact how we hear it?

What is it that has most struck you about the privilege of our calling as Christians in chapters 1–3 (who we are and what we have in the risen Lord Jesus)?

How would really grasping this impact how we walk? What does it mean to walk 'worthy' of our calling?

What will it mean for us to walk i) 'with humility and gentleness' towards each other ii) 'with patience' iii) 'bearing with one another in love' (v2)? What will that look like at the time we are in now?

Why does God want us to be 'eager to maintain/guard the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace' (v3)? How does this challenge our priorities? What will it look like in practise? Read over verses 4–6. Why does Paul say this? Why do we need to know that we are 'one'?
